ST. LIBORY COMMUNITY CONSOLIDATED SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER 30	
PROPOSITION TO INCREASE THE EDUCATION FUND RATE	
Shall the maximum annual tax rate for education purposes of St. Libory Community Consolidated School District Number 30, St. Clair and Washington Counties, Illinois, commonly known as St. Libory Elementary School be increased and established at 2.4508 percent on the full, fair cash value of taxable property as equalized or assessed by the Department of Revenue instead of 0.92 percent, the maximum rate otherwise applicable to the next taxes to be extended for said purpose?

(a) The district is currently authorized to levy for educational taxes at a rate of 0.92 percent.	
(b) The approximate amount of educational taxes extendable under the maximum rate now in force in said district is the sum of \$114,608.00.	
(c) If the proposition herein is approved, the district will be authorized to levy educational taxes at a maximum rate of 2.4508 percent.	
(d) The approximate amount of educational taxes extendable under the proposed increased rate is the sum of \$306,046.00	
(e) If the proposition herein is approved the percentage increase between the maximum rate the district is currently authorized to levy for educational taxes and the newly authorized rate is 266 percent.
