

**OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS OF THE
WASHINGTON COUNTY BOARD**

MARCH 11, 2014

The reconvened and adjourned meeting of the County Board of Washington County, Illinois was held at the courthouse in Nashville, Illinois on March 11, 2014 for the purpose of transacting county business that might come before the board.

Present and presiding were Chairman David Meyer and Thomas Ganz, County Clerk and Clerk of the board.

Others present were Mitch Burdick, Ronda Groennert, Rick Greten, Alan Wiggers, Fred & Corrine Reid, Matt & Ann Meinert, Mark & Linda Baldwin, Alex Haglund, Jim Dalaviras, Mike Muentner, Jesse Cantrell, Garret & Heather Maschhoff, Chad & Jesse Kottmeyer, Loyd Meinert, Charlie Parker, Linda Tragesser, Amy & Chris Kasten and Heath Hooks.

Following the Lord's Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance, Chairman Meyer called the meeting of the Washington County Board to order at 7:00pm.

Roll call was taken by Clerk Ganz with 15 members present and 0 absent. Those present were Barczewski, Gill Muentner, Lisk, Suedmeyer, Evans, Todd, Kurwicky, Hohlt, Spenner, Ibendahl, Shubert, Riechmann, Brammeier and Meyer.

Chairman Meyer asked if there were any corrections to the minutes of the February 11, 2014 meeting. With no corrections a motion was made by Kurwicky and seconded by Brammeier to accept the minutes as presented. Motion carried.

Mitch Burdick, County Engineer, gave his monthly report to the board. Burdick on behalf of the Road & Bridge Committee presented a resolution to accept the 2014 Motor Fuel Tax Aggregate Bids. **(See Exhibit A)** A motion was made by Evans and seconded by Riechmann to accept the resolution as presented. Motion carried.

Burdick also told the board that as of now the cost of snow removal is up to about \$140,000.

The Claims Against the County Report was presented to the board for approval.

TO THE CHAIRMAN AND MEMBERS OF THE BOARD: YOUR COMMITTEE ON MARCH 10, 2014 HAS EXAMINED ALL CLAIMS PRESENTED AND RECOMMENDS PAYMENT TO THE FOLLOWING AND THE CLERK BE DIRECTED TO ISSUE ORDERS ON THE COUNTY TREASURER TO THE CLAIMANTS FOR THE AMOUNTS ALLOWED. **(See Exhibit B)** Evans told the board that the amount of bills this month has totaled \$168,000. This is down compared to past months due to the fact that the judicial building is reaching completion. He also told the board that the cost of the X-ray machine for the Judicial

Building will come out of the Court Funds and the cost of furniture so far has come to approximately \$27,000. Evans made a motion to pay all claims presented and to include a bill to the Illinois State Rifle Assoc. for \$400 for the inspection of the Alan Wiggers shooting range. A second to the motion was made by Muentner. Roll call vote was taken with 15 ayes and 0 nays. Motion carried.

The State's Attorney Monthly Report was presented to the board. (See Exhibit C) A motion was made by Spenner and seconded by Lisk to accept the report as presented. Motion carried.

The County Clerk & Recorder's Monthly Report was presented to the board for approval. (See Exhibit D) Ganz told the board that his office had problems getting election judges for the General Primary Election mainly because younger people can not afford to take off the day to work it and secondly the county needs to consider increasing the election judge pay. Currently the judges receive \$100 and if they have completed the schooling they receive an additional \$20. He stated that this is not enough pay to sit in the polls from 5 am until 8 pm or sometimes later. A motion was made by Gill and seconded by Hohlt to accept the report as presented. Motion carried.

The Sheriff's Monthly Report was presented to the board. (See Exhibit E) A motion was made by Suedmeyer and seconded by Ibendahl to accept the report. Motion carried.

The Emergency Ambulance and Rescue Service Monthly Report was presented to the board for approval. (See Exhibit F) A motion was made by Shubert and seconded by Muentner to accept the report as presented. Motion carried.

Ronda Groennert, County Treasurer, gave her quarterly report to the board. Groennert provided the board with handouts of the 2012 taxes collected and distributed. She told the board that there were 195 parcels up for tax sale and 138 of those were sold for the amount of \$43,099.70.

Zoning Request #001-14 – Dolan Realty Advisors, LLC – Ordinance for special use permit– (ORDINANCE #014-05) the location of a 280 foot cell tower. (See Exhibit G) A motion was made by Shubert and seconded by Spenner to grant the request. Roll call vote was taken with 15 ayes and 0 nays. Motion carried.

The matter of the Wigger's shooting facility was discussed. Shubert told the board that a representative from the Illinois State Rifle Assoc. was at the shooting facility and will report back soon. Wiggers agreed not to shoot at the facility until the report is back from the inspector and changes have been made.

Kurwicki made a motion to rescind ordinance for special use permit, adopted January 13, 2014, granting a special use permit (application #003-13) by Alan Wiggers) to permit a teaching facility for On Target Academy, LLC (a handgun training facility) on the following property: 5.22 acres in the SW corner of the SW1/4 of the SE1/4 of Section 22, T.2.S –R.3W of the 3rd PM

in Washington County, Illinois. A second to the motion was made by Todd. Evans called for a roll call vote. Roll call vote was taken with 5 ayes and 10 nays. Motion failed. Those voting aye were Todd, Kurwicky, Hohlt, Riechmann and Meyer. Those voting nay were Barczewski, Gill, Muentner, Lisk, Suedmeyer, Evans, Spenner, Ibendahl, Shubert and Brammeier.

Kurwicky made a motion to modify ordinance for special use permit, adopted January 14, 2014, granting a special use permit (application #003-13 by Alan Wiggers) to permit a teaching facility for On Target Academy, LLC (a handgun training facility) on the following property: 5.22 acres in the SW corner of the SW1/4 of the SE1/4 of Section 22, T.2S – R.3W of the 3rd PM in Washington County, Illinois. A second to the motion was made by Todd. The board asked what modifications were to be made. With no definite modifications, Kurwicky stated that she would withdraw the motion and it was seconded by Todd.

At this time Chairman Meyer called for committee reports.

A motion was made by Shubert and seconded by Lisk to accept the appointments as presented. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Shubert and seconded by Evans to accept the names as submitted. Motion carried. There is still one more appointment needed for the Hospital Board and it will be advertised.

Building Committee – Suedmeyer told the board that they need a change order for the county building contingency which was \$50,000 and is over \$1,795.13. A motion was made by Suedmeyer and seconded by Riechmann to approve the overage. Motion carried. Todd voted nay.

A motion was made by Brammeier and seconded by Spenner to order new benches for the lobby of the new judicial building. There will be three benches, 10 foot, 8 foot and 16 foot at the cost of \$5,975. Riechmann called for a roll call vote. Roll call was taken with 9 ayes and 6 nays.

Motion carried. Those voting aye were Gill, Muentner, Lisk, Suedmeyer, Hohlt, Spenner, Ibendahl, Brammeier and Meyer. Those voting nay were Barczewski, Evans, Todd, Kurwicki, Shubert and Riechmann.

The board was told that the tentative date for the dedication has been set for Sunday April 27, 2014 at 2:00pm.

The board was told that 14 hard top computers have been ordered for the Sheriff and Ambulance Departments at the cost of \$1300 each. Nine will go to the Sheriff's Dept. and five to the Ambulance Service. There will also be 21 more computers ordered for other departments at the cost of \$23,337. This is due to the changes from Windows XP to Windows 7. The total cost will be approximately \$43,000 plus and Miken has agreed to let the county pay half this year and the other half next year. A motion was made by Riechmann to move forward with the purchases and upgrades. A second to the motion was made by Spenner. Motion carried.

The Miken renewal contract is \$30,155 and this includes our credit we currently have. A motion was made by Hohlt and seconded by Kurwicki to accept the contract. Motion carried.

Brammeier told the board that recycling dates have been set for April 12th, June 14th, Aug. 9th and Oct. 11th.

A letter of support for the renewal and extension of the Nashville/Washington County Enterprise Zone was presented to the board for the Chairman's signature. A motion was made by Evans and seconded by Ibendahl to support it. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Evans and seconded by Suedmeyer to pay all bills, utilities, payroll, overtime and insurance. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Hohlt and seconded by Muentner to adjourn until April 8, 2014 at 7:00pm. Motion carried. The meeting of the Washington County Board adjourned at 9:10pm.
