OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS

WASHINGTON COUNTY BOARD MEETING

NOVEMBER 14, 2017

The reconvened and adjourned meeting of the County Board of Washington County, Illinois was held at the Washington County Courthouse in Nashville, Illinois on November 14, 2017 for the purpose of transacting county business that might come before the Board.

Present and presiding were Chairman Meyer and Nancy Heseman, County Clerk and Clerk of the Board.

Others present were, Linda Tragesser, Dan Bronke, Mitch Burdick, Sheriff Bradac, Trey Meier and Debbie Stricker.

Following the Lord's Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance, Chairman Meyer called the meeting of the Washington County Board to order at 7:00 p.m.

Roll call was taken by Clerk Heseman with 13 members present. Those present were, Suedmeyer, Unverfehrt, Evans, Todd, Hohlt, Spenner, Shubert, Ibendahl, Shemonic, Barczewski, Brammeier, Eigenrauch and Meyer. Muentner & Bening were not present.

Chairman Meyer asked if there were any corrections to the minutes from the October 10, 2017 County Board Meeting. With no corrections, a motion was made by Hohlt seconded by Shemonic to approve the minutes as presented. Motion carried.

Muentner entered meeting at 7:05 p.m.

**Highway Department:** No resolutions. Burdick did report to the Board that the Highway Department has completed all the mowing and road work for this year. Highway Department is well stocked with salt for the winter months, with the ability to order more at a reasonable price if necessary. Road & Bridge Committee did host John Shubert, he is the Washington County Representative with South Central Transit Board, and he will continue to keep the Road & Bridge Committee updated and informed.

**The Claims against the County** report was presented to the Board for approval. TO THE CHAIRMAN AND MEMBERS OF THE BOARD: YOUR COMMITTEE ON November 13, 2017 EXAMINED ALL CLAIMS PRESENTED AND RECOMMENDS PAYMENT TO THE FOLLOWING AND THE CLERK BE DIRECTED TO ISSUE ORDER ON THE COUNTY TREASURER TO THE CLAIMANTS FOR THE AMOUNT ALLOWED. (See Exhibit A) Evans stated the Committee met and found all bills to be in order. A motion was made by Evans and seconded by Shubert to make restitution to those claims against the county. Roll call vote was taken with 14 ayes and 0 nays. Motion carried.

Brammeier reported, per the State's Attorney, that a separate roll call vote is needed to approve County Board Members Expenses, and along with that any county employee that goes over the expense limits per the County Code, must be pre-approved prior to travel. Both these items should be on the agenda and a roll call vote to approve needs to be taken.

A motion was made by Brammeier and seconded by Muentner to approve the County Board Members Expenses for this past month. Roll call vote was taken with 14 ayes and 0 nays. Motion carried.

**The State's Attorney Monthly Report** was presented to the Board for approval. (See Exhibit B). A motion was made by Spenner and seconded by Eigenrauch to accept the report as presented. Motion carried.

**The County Clerk & Recorder's Monthly Report** was presented to the Board for approval. (See Exhibit C) Clerk Heseman did report that the office is now using Fidar as their company for recording. The report this month is a couple of extra pages because part of the month we were with CIC and the other part of the month we were with Fidar. This new program offers an online service for someone just wanting to search an item. A person would have to enter a charge card for that service. The other services would be monthly bills with user names and passwords. There are fees attached to both of these services. At this time the records on line only go back to 2001, but has hopes to get some back indexing done and eventually have a lot more of the old records available on line. A motion was made by Suedmeyer and seconded by Shemonic to approve the report as presented. Motion carried.

**The Sheriff's Monthly Report** was presented to the Board for approval. (See Exhibit D). A motion was made by Suedmeyer and seconded by Shubert to approve the report, but date of Notary needs to be corrected from October to November. Motion carried.

**The Emergency Ambulance and Rescue Service Monthly Report** was presented to the Board for approval. (See Exhibit E) A motion was made by Shubert and seconded by Spenner to accept the report as presented. Motion carried.

**The Treasurer's Cash Flow Statement and Budgetary Status Reports for period ending 10/31/17** were presented to the Board. (See Exhibits F & G) A motion was made by Shemonic and seconded by Suedmeyer to accept the report as presented subject to audit review. Motion carried.

**Zoning:** No zoning requests this month.

**Mental Health Budget & Levy:** Was approved at the October Board Meeting.

**Washington County Tax Levy Ordinance & County Budget:** Chairman Meyer asked if anyone had any questions, the Levy & Budget was given to the Board Members last month for review, before voting on it at the November Board meeting. Todd asked about the planned spending from surplus, this is the last year for the County to be receiving the Prairie State Money. How can we increase spending when revenue is decreasing? Malawy explained how the planned spending from surplus is being handled. Suedmeyer replied the Finance Committee did cut spending for other areas. The money received from Prairie State was to be on infrastructure only. Todd inquired about the increase for the Regional Supt of Schools. Suedmeyer replied the County budget was based on the Regional Office of Education's proposed budget. Todd is worried about what happens when the County runs out of money. Malawy replied Washington County has been very fortunate that the EAV in Washington County has been increasing. Ibendahl inquired were does the interest generated from Prairie State's money show in the budget book. Malawy replied it is broke out in the county audit, but not in the county budget. The interest is being used in the general fund. With no more questions Meyer asked for a motion. A motion

was made by Barczewski and seconded by Evans to accept and approve the Levy & Budget as presented. Roll call vote was taken with 14 ayes and 0 nays. Motion carried. (See Exhibit H & I)

**Committee Meetings:**

**Insurance:** Hohlt reported to the Board he received the quote for the County Insurance renewal policy, it is about a 6% increase and will be brought before the Board at the December Board Meeting.

**County Building:** Suedmeyer requested going into executive session under (2-C-5) (Real Estate), and (2-C-1) (Employees) at the end of the meeting.

**Ambulance:** Shubert addressed the Board concerning fee increase for the Ambulance Department. The Ambulance Committee is in agreement to bring this fee increase to the full Board. The additional fee is for 9-1-1 calls that refuse transport, they are using 9-1-1 instead of going to their Doctor and have no intention of being transported. Surrounding counties are already charging a fee for this, and the Committee is suggesting to the Board a \$50.00 charge for these types of calls. If a person other than the victim calls 9-1-1 and that victim refuses transport the victim would not be charged this fee. A motion was made by Shubert and seconded by Muentner to implement a \$50.00 fee on non-transfer calls where the person initiated the call. Motion carried.

**Personnel, Policy and Appointments:** Shubert presented the following name to the County Board for appointment to the Washington County Zoning Board of Appeals. Luke Borrenpohl to serve an unexpired term of Larry Kuhlengel.

A motion was made by Shubert and seconded by Spenner to approve the re-appointments as presented. Motion carried.

**County Buildings:** Suedmeyer asked to go into closed session for 1 item following the Committee Reports.

Chairman Meyer asked if the public would like to speak if they have any questions or comments. There were no comments or questions.

Meyer discussed Christmas lunch for the County Employees and asked for \$25.00 per County Board Member to cover this cost. The lunch is being planned for Tuesday, December 12, 2017 this will be the same day as the County Board Meeting. Lunch will be served from 11:00-1:00.

The Co-op Extension Budget and Levy will be added to the December County Board Agenda to be approved by the County Board.

A motion was made by Suedmeyer and seconded by Unverfehrt to enter into executive session under (2-C-5) (Real Estate) (Purchase or Lease by County), and asked for the Sheriff, State's Attorney and Gary Malawy to remain for the closed session. Roll call vote was taken with 14 ayes and 0 nays. Motion carried.

Entered into executive session at 8:00 p.m.

Return to open session at 8:15 p.m.

Shubert informed the Board that Heartlands Conservancy would like the Nature Preserve to be a part of the Jingle Hike that is being planned between Thanksgiving & Christmas. Shubert feels this would give some recognition to the Nature Preserve. Shubert informed the Board that a lot of the trees on the path were marked with plaques that said what kind of tree it is, some of the plaques are bad and need replaced, the Heartlands Conservancy would like to replace these with no cost to the County. Shubert just wanted to inform the Board of this request hoping there was no problem with him giving permission for them using the Washington County Nature Preserve for the Jingle Hike. Meyer stated he was concerned about this due to the fact there was a 15 year agreement with the Storks concerning the use of this property, and would like to review this agreement first.

A motion was made by Evans and seconded by Suedmeyer to pay utility bills, payroll and overtime. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Hohlt and seconded by Eigenrauch to adjourn until December 12, 2017 at 3:00 P.M. Motion carried. The meeting of the Washington County Board adjourned at 8:22 P.M.




