
**VOTING BY MAIL STRONGLY ENCOURAGED FOR COUNTY RESIDENTS CONCERNED ABOUT  
CORONAVIRUS**

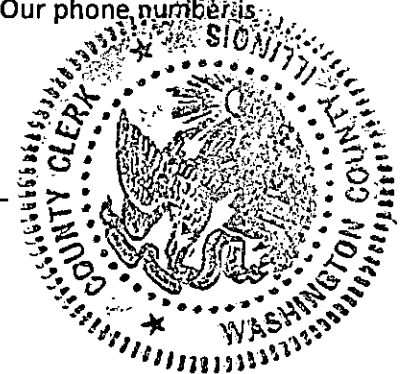
Washington County – With coronavirus a continuing concern as the 2020 General Election approaches, County Clerk, Nancy Heseman encourages voters to consider voting by mail as a safe, secure and convenient option to in-person voting.

The Washington County Clerk is in the process of mailing all registered voters an application to vote by mail for the November 3, 2020 General Election. If you would like to vote by mail all you have to do is sign and date the application, there is a space to give a different address if the ballot needs to be mailed to a different location. Once the application is completed return it to the County Clerk's office.

Ballots will be mailed out starting September 24, which is the first day to mail a ballot. Ballots will include a postage paid envelope for returning the ballot. Last day a ballot can be mailed out is *Thursday, October 29, 2020*. Ballots must be postmarked no later than November 3 to be accepted, ballots postmarked by November 3<sup>rd</sup> will be accepted through November 17, 2020.
