NOTICE OF EARLY VOTING  
SEPTEMBER 24 – NOVEMBER 2, 2020

Under Early Voting a registered voter does not have to offer a reason to vote early. Early voting will be conducted at the County Clerk's Office, during regular business hours, 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

The office will be closed on Monday, October 12, 2020 in observance of Columbus Day.


A registered voter can also request an application for a ballot be mailed and vote by mail.

Last day a ballot can be mailed is Thursday, October 29, 2020.

Due to COVID-19, all 2020 General Election voters are encouraged to cast a ballot prior to Election Day, either by mail or during early voting. Voting by mail is an easy option for voters and you can request a vote by mail ballot through email, mail, or in person. An application is available for your local election authority or at
