SEPTEMBER 24 – NOVEMBER 2, 2020


Under Early Voting a registered voter does not have to offer a reason to vote early. Early voting will be conducted at the County Clerk's Office

A registered voter can also request an application for a ballot to be mailed and vote by mail. Last day a ballot can be mailed is Thursday, October 29, 2020.
