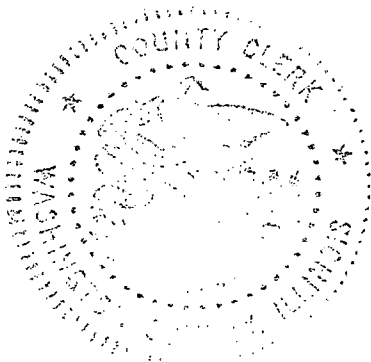



Voting Notice

Early Voting *February 25th – April 5th*

Under early voting, a registered voter wishing to vote before Election Day can do so in the County Clerk's Office

Vote by Mail *February 25th – April 1st*

A registered voter, who wishes to vote by mail, can do so by contacting the County Clerk's Office by phone, email, or in person. The last day the County Clerk's Office can receive an application for a ballot to be mailed is Thursday, April 1st, 2021.

Close of Voter Registration *March 9th*

March 9th, 2021 is the last day for regular voter registration or transfer of registration for the Consolidated General Election. Regular voting registration re-opens on April 8th, 2021.

Grace Period Voting *March 10th – April 6th*

Grace Period Voting is where you register to vote and/or transfer your voting information and vote **THE SAME DAY** (including Election Day) in the County Clerk's Office.
