Tim—I am building a house. The existing septic system in in the way. It is easier to get a variance than to move the septic tank.

Matt- It is on a corner lot but I do not see any problem with obstructing views to vehicles coming up to the intersection.

Mike-I would think this would be a limited thing, is it necessary?

Matt- yes again without it we have no control.

Butch- does fire departments have equipment to deal with this kind of fire?

Matt- no and that would be addressed in this ordinance. They would need a SUP and we could require they get the equipment for the department.

Devin- Lets just not allow them in our county.

Matt- we can do that BUT it would be just like the solar and Wind. To many counties said no so the big companies bought lobbyist who got the legislators to pass the laws that forced us to rewrite ours.

I am not asking for a decision tonight, I will put it on the next agenda when we are ready for it.
