The reconvened and adjourned meeting of the County Board of Washington County, Illinois was held at the Washington County Courthouse Nashville, Illinois on August 9, 2022 for the purpose of transacting county business that might come before the Board.

Present and presiding were Chairman David Meyer and Shari Hempen, County Clerk & Clerk of the Board.

Others present were, Dan Janowski-State's Attorney, Natalie Lynch-Treasurer, Kiefer Heiman-Highway Supervisor, Ross Schultze, Linda Tragesser-SIMAPC, John Felchlia-Ambulance Administrator.

Following the Lord's Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance, Chairman Meyer called the meeting of the Washington County Board to order at 7:05 p.m.

Roll Call was taken by Clerk Hempen with 13 Board members present. Those present were Hohlt, Klingenberg, Shemonic, Small, Suedmeyer, Unverfehrt, Barczewski, Bening, Brammeier, Meyer, Muenter, Ibendahl and Todd. Absent was Karg and Lamczyk.

Karg entered the meeting at 7:10 pm

(See Exhibit A) Motion was made by Ibendahl and seconded by Small to accept the report as presented. Roll call vote was taken with 14 ayes, 0 nays and 1 absent. Motion carried. There was a question about the cost of replacement trash cans for the Storck Nature Preserve. Suedmeyer told the board that that there have been ongoing issues with the trash cans being destroyed so more durable ones might help with that.

A motion was made by Ibendahl and seconded by Muenter to make restitution to the County Board's Per Diems. Motion carried.


