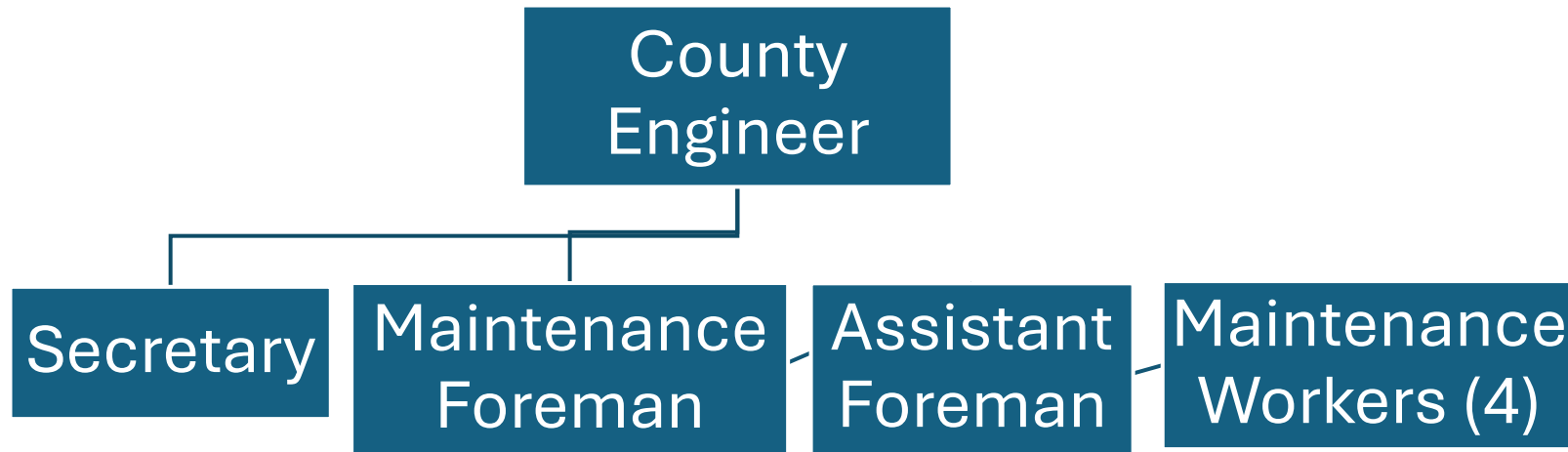


The function of the Washington County Highway Department is to safeguard the safety of the travelling public through responsible planning, design, construction, operation, and maintenance of county highways, bridges, and culverts.

The organizational structure is as follows and is subject to change:



The Washington County Highway Department 2026 fiscal year budgets are:

Highway Fund: \$1,024,000

Bridge Fund: \$510,000

Matching Fund: \$231,800

The Washington County Highway Department is overseen by the Road and Bridge Committee and the County Board.

Committee meetings are typically on the first Wednesday of the month at 7pm.

## **SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR DOCUMENTS PURSUANT TO THE ILLINOIS FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 5 ILCS 140/1**

First 50 Pages (B&W, Letter/Legal): Free.

Additional Pages (B&W, Letter/Legal): Maximum 15 cents per page.

Color or Abnormal Size Copies: Actual cost of reproduction.

Electronic Records: Actual cost of the recording medium (e.g., CD, flash drive).

Certification Fee: A fee of \$1.00 per page may be charged for certified copies.

Search/Review Fees: Up to \$10 per hour for personnel time spent searching for or retrieving records, after the first 8 hours.
