OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS WASHINGTON COUNTY BOARD MEETING MAY 12, 2020

The reconvened and adjourned meeting of the County Board of Washington County, Illinois was held at the Washington County Courthouse in Nashville, Illinois on May 12, 2020 for the purpose of transacting County business that might come before the Board.

Present and presiding were Chairman Meyer and Shari Hempen Chief Deputy, and Deputy Clerk of the Board.

Following the Lord's Prayer and the Piedge of Allegiance, Chairman Meyer called the meeting of the Washington County Board to order at 7:05 p.m.

This meeting was a Tele-A-conference meeting. Chairman Meyer requested that during roll call members would state if present or by phone.

Roll call was taken by Deputy Clerk Hempen with 14 members present. Those present at the meeting were Lamczyk, Muenter, Shubert, Small, Todd, Brammeier, Ibendahl and Meyer. Those present by phone were Klingenberg, Shemonic, Suedmeyer, Unverfehrt, Barczewski and Hohlt. Bening was absent.

Guests present was Matt Bierman, those present by phone were Natalie Lynch, Dan Bronke, John Felchlia, Elizabeth Lehde, Kiefer Heiman, Linda Tregrasser and Leah Williams-Nashville News, Debbie Stricker-Okawville Times.

Chairman Meyer asked if there were any corrections to the minutes from the April 14, 2020 County Board meeting. With no corrections, a motion was made by Ibendahl and seconded by Barczewski to approve the minutes as presented. Motion carried

Highway Department:

Kiefer Heiman presented to the board:

RESOLUTION #2020-18, A Resolution to repair a failing drainage structure, consisting of a 36" cross culvert on TR 44, Coolidge Road, Johannisburg Road District, located 800 ft. south of Harding Road in Section 36 T2S, 5W. (See Exhibit A)

RESOLUTION #2020-19, A Resolution to repair a failing drainage structure, consisting of a 36" cross culvert on TR 44, Coolidge Road, Johannisburg Road District, located 1600 ft. south of Harding Road in Section 36, T2s, R5W. (See Exhibit B)

RESOLUTION #2020-20, A Resolution to repair a failing drainage structure, consisting of a 72" cross culvert on TR 44, Coolidge Road, Johannisburg Road District, located 300 ft. north of County Highway 10 in Section 36, T2S, 5W. (See Exhibit C)

A motion was made by Brammeier to accept and approve the 3 resolutions for Johannisburg Township and seconded by Klingenberg. Motion carried.

RESOLUTION #2020-21, A Resolution to repair a failing drainage structure, consisting of a 36" culvert crossing TR 103, Grouse Road, Venedy Road District, located in the east of Section 32, T1S, R5W. (See Exhibit D)

A motion was made by Brammeier to accept and approve the resolution for Venedy Township and seconded by Small. Motion carried.

The Claims against the County report was presented to the Board for approval by Ibendahi. TO THE CHAIRMAN AND MEMBERS OF THE BOARD: YOUR COMMITTEE ON May 11, 2020 EXAMINED ALL CLAIMS PRESENTED AND RECOMMENDS PAYMENT TO THE FOLLOWING AND THE CLERK BE DIRECTED TO ISSUE ORDER ON THE COUNTY TREASURER TO THE CLAIMANTS FOR THE AMOUNT ALLOWED. (See Exhibit E) A motion was made by Ibendahi and seconded by Lamczyk to make restitution to those claims against the County. Roll call vote was taken with 14 ayes and 0 nays. Motion carried.

Dave Meyer told the Board Members that if any of their committee meetings pertain to Covid-19 that they should list C-19 for that meeting.

A motion was made by Suedmeyer and seconded by Klingenberg to make restitution to the County Board's Per Diems. Motion carried.

The State's Attorney Monthly Report was presented to the Board for approval. (See Exhibit F). A motion was made by Shubert and seconded by Muenter to accept the report as presented. Motion carried.

The County Clerk & Recorder's Monthly Report was presented to the Board for approval. (See Exhibit G). A motion was made by Barczewski and seconded by Hohlt to approve the report as presented.

Motion carried.

The Sheriff's Monthly Report was presented to the Board for approval. (See Exhibit H). A motion was made by Shubert and seconded by Todd to approve the report as presented. Motion carried.

Chairman Meyer informed the Board that former Sheriff Jerry Borrenpohl had passed away and that the County Flag was being flown at half-staff in his honor for 3 days.

The Emergency Ambulance and Rescue Service Monthly Report was presented to the Board for approval. (See Exhibit I). A motion was made by Shubert and seconded by Muenter to accept the report as presented. Motion carried. Shubert told the board that the run numbers were down and that the Ambulance Department had to replace a transmission in one of their ambulances at a cost of \$14,600.00

The Treasurer's Monthly Cash Flow Statement and Budgetary Status Reports for Period Ending 04/30/2020 was presented to the Board. (See Exhibits J & K). A motion was made by Shemonic and seconded by Hohlt to accept the report as presented subject to audit review. Motion carried.

Zoning: No Cases to report

A motion was made by Small and seconded by Muenter for Chairman Meyer to sign a **Proclamation for National Alcohol and Drug Prevention week May 10-16, 2020.** Motion carried. (See Exhibit L).

Elizabeth Lehde of the Health Department gave an update on Covid-19. The Health Department is currently following 2 active COVID-19 cases and has had 14 others who have recovered from the disease. 1 of the cases had been hospitalized. There have been 211 negative results reported to the

health department. It is difficult to determine exactly what has kept our numbers down, but a lot of hard work by our healthcare teams and the cooperation from the citizens of Washington County have undoubtedly contributed. The mission of the health department is to protect, promote and preserve the health of the residents of Washington County.

Matt Bierman the EMA Coordinator updated the board on his office. He is making sure that the First Responders have what they need to protect themselves. His office is working on compiling numbers for the Covid-19 grant. The Grant is called a 25/75 Split. The County is responsible for 25 % of money spent so far on the virus. That 25 % can be recouped from In Kind volunteer hours or donations. Bierman said that the Health Department has gotten a \$35,000 grant already and the Ambulance Department has received a \$22,665.43 grant to help offset money lost due to Covid-19. Bierman handed out (informational only) a spreadsheet of the costs to the county so far. (See Exhibit M)

Suedmeyer stated that the Finance Committee had a meeting on Monday to go over the numbers turned in so far from the expenses incurred from Covid-19. After an extensive meeting the committee decided to stay at Status Quo and follow the State's mandates, and to proceed cautiously when opening things up. It was the Finance Committee's recommendation for Bronke to draw up a Press Release from the board on the current situation. Chairman Meyer asked for a motion to proceed with the Press Release no motion was made. Several Board members voiced their opinions on the current situation and press release.

Small said that these are just orders from the Governor and not laws. He agrees with having a statement but ours sounds like we agree with the state and you better do what it says. He is not sure that is what the people who voted for us want to hear from us. Ibendahl stated that we need to be careful with the type of stuff we enforce. Suedmeyer said that we cannot dictate to the people necessarily what they do they are kind of on their own, but just want to caution them on what may be lost if going against State Mandate. Meyer said the statement is not a necessity but it does not change anything, it is what it is yet. It is up to the Board to decide to proceed with the statement. No motion was made to proceed. The County will not do a press release, but we are still under the state's ruling and state license could be lost if people do not follow the rules.

Committee is still looking for someone to serve on the Washington County Hospital Board. Candidate needs to be from the Oakdale-Pilot Knob area. If no one takes the seat the committee will be forced to appoint someone from another township.

Hohlt told the board still continuing to have problems with dispatch with the way they are receiving and handling 911 calls. It's coming from their training and supervision and does not feel it is sufficient down there. They have spent in the neighborhood of a little over \$300,000.00 to upgrade the systems. The people taking and receiving 911 calls are not utilizing the equipment to its max. He stated we are not giving the people in this County the best service that could be. He is asking that the Communication, 911 and Chairman of the County Board meet and seriously look at the situation in dispatch. It is not a problem that just started, it has been going on for almost 2 years and we are not going anywhere with the current rate. It needs to be addressed. It is a very serious situation. Klingenberg stated that he has received complaints on calls that were being reported and major issue.
