WASHINGTON COUNTY BOARD MEETING

SEPTEMBER 8, 2020

The reconvened and adjourned meeting of the County Board of Washington County, Illinois was held at the Washington County Courthouse in Nashville, Illinois on September 8, 2020 for the purpose of transacting County business that might come before the Board.

Present and presiding were Chairman Meyer and Nancy Heseman, County Clerk and Clerk of the Board.

Others present were, Matt Bierman and Elizabeth Lehde, present by phone was Kiefer Heiman, Dan Bronke, Nashville News, Okawville Times, John Felchlia and Natalie Lynch.

Following the Lord's Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance, Chairman Meyer called the meeting of the Washington County Board to order at 7:10 p.m.

Roll call was taken by Clerk Heseman with 14 members present. Those present were, Shubert, Suedmeyer, Bening, Small, Barczewski, Shemonic, Brammeier, Unverfehrt, Todd, Lamczyk, Klingenberg, Ibendahl and Meyer. Present by phone was Hohlt. Shubert and Suedmeyer.

Chairman Meyer asked if there were any corrections to the minutes from the August 11, 2020 County Board meeting. With no corrections, a motion was made by Brammeier and seconded by Shemonic to approve the minutes as presented. Motion carried.

The Claims against the County report was presented to the Board for approval by Ibendahl. TO THE CHAIRMAN AND MEMBERS OF THE BOARD: YOUR COMMITTEE ON September 4, 2020 EXAMINED ALL CLAIMS PRESENTED AND RECOMMENDS PAYMENT TO THE FOLLOWING AND THE CLERK BE DIRECTED TO ISSUE ORDER ON THE COUNTY TREASURER TO THE CLAIMANTS FOR THE AMOUNT ALLOWED. (See Exhibit A) A motion was made by Ibendahl and seconded by Suedmeyer to make restitution to those claims against the County. Roll call vote was taken with 15 ayes and 0 nays. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Ibendahl and seconded by Bening to make restitution to the County Board's Per Diems. Motion carried.

The State's Attorney Monthly Report was presented to the Board for approval. (See Exhibit B). A motion was made by Klingenberg and seconded by Todd to accept the report as presented. Motion carried.

The County Clerk & Recorder's Monthly Report was presented to the Board for approval. (See Exhibit C) A motion was made by Small and seconded by Lamczyk to approve the report as presented. Motion carried.

Resolution Requiring Permanent Index Number (See Exhibit D). A motion was made by Shemonic and seconded by Muentner to approve the resolution as presented. Motion carried.

The Sheriff's Monthly Report was presented to the Board for approval. (See Exhibit E). A motion was made by Unverfehrt and seconded by Shubert to approve the report as presented. Motion carried.

The Emergency Ambulance and Rescue Service Monthly Report: (See Exhibit F). A motion was made by Shubert and seconded by Bening to approve the report as presented. Motion carried.

The Treasurer's Monthly Cash Flow Statement and Budgetary Status Reports for Period Ending 08/31/2020 was presented to the Board. (See Exhibits G & H). A motion was made by Klingenberg and seconded by Shemonic to accept the report as presented subject to audit review. Motion carried. Klingenberg inquired about the Ambulance Balance on the report. Suedmeyer & Shubert explained that the Ambulance Department had to borrow \$50,000.00 from Prairie State Fund this month. The Ambulance Department has a \$50,000.00 CD but it will not come due until October so they did not want to cash it in early. When the CD comes due they will re-pay the Prairie State Fund.

Zoning: (Ordinance#2020-13) (See Exhibit I) Ordinance to Amend Zoning Map. Application #Z009-20 was presented by Matthew and Heather Brand requesting an amendment changing the Zone District Classification on 2.5 acres of 5 acres of Pt of the S ½ SW ¼ of SW ¼ & Pt SE ¼ SW ¼ Sec 33 T1N R 3 W from Ag to R-1 Rural Residential to permit Rural Residential uses. The Zoning Board of Appeals recommends this be approved by the County Board. A motion was made by Shubert and seconded by Small to grant the request as presented. Roll call vote was taken with 15 ayes, 0 abstain and 0 nays. Motion carried.

Zoning: (Ordinance#2020-14) (See Exhibit J) Ordinance to Amend Zoning Map. Application #Z010-20 was presented by Steve Karmeier, requesting an amendment changing the Zone District Classification on 2 acres of 5 acres Pt of the S ½ NW ¼ Section 19, T1S R2W from Ag to R-1 (Rural Residential) to permit Rural Residential uses. The Zoning Board of Appeals recommends this be approved by the County Board. A motion was made by Shubert and seconded by Suedmeyer to grant the request as presented. Roll call vote was taken with 15 ayes, 0 abstain and 0 nays. Motion carried.

Highway Department: Keifer Heiman presented to the Board:

RESOLUTION #2020-29, A Resolution to replace a damaged drainage structure, consisting of a single 30" culvert, on TR 33, Bluebird Road, 1680' west of State Route 127, Hoyleton Township, Section 7 T1S R2W. (See Exhibit K) A motion was made by Brammeier and seconded by Unverfehrt to approve the resolution as presented. Suedmeyer abstained due to conflict of interest. Motion carried.

RESOLUTON #2020-30, A Resolution to replace a damaged drainage structure, consisting of a double 36" culver, on TR 194a, Magnolia Road, 260' south of Cottonwood Road, Hoyleton Township, Section 34, T1N R2W. (See Exhibit L) A motion was made by Brammeier and seconded by Lamczyk to approve the resolution as presented. Suedmeyer abstained due to conflict of interest. Motion carried.

Resolution to Rescind Declaration of Local Disaster was presented to the Board by Todd. A motion was made by Suedmeyer and seconded by Todd to table this resolution until next month. Motion carried. Meyer appreciated this decision to give the County time to investigate this issue more.

Resolution To Offer Support To All Local Businesses That Lie Within The Boundaries Of Washington County, Illinois. (See Exhibit M) Todd explained this is nothing to do against Government, it just a Symbolic move showing the County Board supports our local businesses. Lehde and Bierman address the board with issues and concerns about COVID and frustration with IDPH and Government. Board discussed the need to send a letter to the Governor addressing the concerns the County is having during this pandemic. A motion was made by Todd and seconded by Klingenberg to accept this resolution as presented. Todd requested roll call vote. Roll call vote 15 ayes, 0 nays and 0 absent, motion carried.





WHEREAS, there has been established in Washington County, Illinois a permanent real estate index number system; and



WHEREAS, the residents of Washington County would benefit from the increased efficiency of the Clerk/Recorder's Office.


